BALTIMORE - Jess! Pfohl presents her latest creative works, *Cut Canvas*, during the month of July in The Black Room at the Alchemy of Art, Baltimore.

Cut Canvas is a mixed-media on layered canvas display. Jess! combines elements of study from the past year, to create multi dimensional inverted wall pieces that explore a combination of literal meaning with feminine qualities and characteristics resulting in strong imagery.

The artist hopes to reflect empowerment without being overpowering.

Jess! creates the works by using recycled printed canvases. Painting the backside in various colored layers; the canvas takes on a screen-printed feel. Second layers are painted on the same material in street art, pop art influences. All pieces are hand cut to shape and sewn using a traditional sewing machine. By allowing the material to dictate direction, the artist bends pieces to shape to create dimension so layers protrude from the canvas. The pieces are then stretched atop detailed frames, to create an inverted finished feel.

The collection shows 20 pieces. The exhibition is separated into categories to reflect fine art in commercial art settings, floral and Baltimore inspired.

Jess! Pfohl is a self-taught 21st century American artist residing in Baltimore, Maryland. Jess! holds degrees from St. Bonaventure University in Journalism and Marketing. In 2012 Jess! was endorsed by Campbell's Soup in celebration of the 50th Anniversary of Andy Warhol's *Campbell's Soup Cans.* In September 2016 Jess! headlined the Music is Art Festival supporting the Goo Goo Dolls with her visual art installation gallery, *Sexposé*.

Jess! has worked with many artists throughout a wide range of mediums including film, photography, textile and music. Jess! attributes the combination of these experiences as being the core influence of her work. Even though the style of work changes and evolves, the subject matter tends to revolve around human behavior.

Jess! has works permanently installed at Brooklyn Bowl in Brooklyn, New York, E-Villa in Atlanta, Georgia and The Alchemy of Art in Baltimore, Maryland.




